



Newman Catholic Collegiate Use of P.E and Sport Funding.

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for physical education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision.

Funding will be allocated to all maintained and state-funded schools with primary phase pupils, including: primary, middle, special and non-maintained special schools, academies and pupil referral units from 1 September 2013. A typical primary school will receive about £9,250 annually in the academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

The Schools within the Newman Catholic Collegiate have pooled a percentage of this Funding, employing a trained P.E Specialist to put into place procedures that will ensure the quality and breath of PE and sport provision is improved.

At the beginning of the academic year all 8 School's completed a self-review of their department, highlighting areas of strength and aspects that could be improved. This self-review will be completed at the end of each term to enable Schools to continually target aspects of their P.E delivery which could be improved further.

Throughout 2013/2014 all of the School's within the Newman Catholic Collegiate will benefit from:

- Teachers receiving 1-to-1 Training with a P.E Specialist in a variety of physical activities, raising the standard of teaching and learning in P.E across the Collegiate.
- An increase in competitive opportunities in a number of Physical Activities.
- All Teaching staff receiving high quality P.E and Sports training focusing on appropriate exercises to challenge learners of all abilities.
- Additional extra-curricular opportunities for pupils to extend their learning.
- A standardised assessment policy implemented throughout the Collegiate.
- An elevated focus on teaching pupils the benefits of Healthy, Active Lifestyles.
