<u>R.E.</u>

When Jesus came alive, He walked along a road with his 2 friends. They were very sad because their friend Jesus had died, and they didn't know that the man who was walking with them was Jesus at first. You can see their sad faces on the picture.



<u>Literacy</u>

During the next few weeks we will be thinking about Journeys. These last few weeks we have been making journeys when we have been for our walks, just like Jesus and his friends, because we can't use our cars very often. Watch and listen to the story 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car' by John Burningham (youtubeorangeblossomchildren's library). Can you retell the story - Beginning, middle and end? Why didn't the animals and the children want to help Mr Gumpy? Why did they have to help in the end? Talk about the importance of all helping and working together.

You might be able to make Mr Gumpy's car from a toilet roll, some card, and scrap paper.



Phonics

Look at the segmenting and blending words on Missbenishteaches on the Phonics part of the Home Learning page. Can you press the sound buttons to read the words?

Number

When you go for a walk with your family, ask if you can go near to a busy road (remember to stay on the pavement!) and look at all the different kinds of vehicles. Can you name them all? What do they look like? See if you can count how many cars, buses, lorries, vans, bicycles, motorbikes you see. Ask an adult to write down the numbers. When you get home, count to see which you saw the most/least of. Draw a picture of them and copy the number on the side.
