



Reception Class Homework Grid- Autumn Term 1 2021

Dear Parents, Reception Class is a crucial year for your child's learning of basic skills in Reading, Writing and Maths and in their understanding of themselves in their world. The following Home Learning tasks will support the work your child will be doing in Literacy and Maths this term, as well as some of the RE and Topic work that we will cover. Please complete one homework task a week, in any order, and record evidence of this in your child's homework book in the form of work, photographs and/ or comments. Your comments may include what your child has said during the activity. It would be very helpful if you could provide the date that each activity was completed.

Don't forget that you can share any photo and video observations of your child at home with us through the Evidence Me App and you can also share any special achievements with us by filling out a WOW card. We hope that you and your child have fun completing these activities together. Thank you for supporting your child's education.

Literacy	What is your favourite book? Can you draw a picture of your favourite character? You might even be able to sound out their name.	Go on a listening walk. What things can you hear? Do they make a loud sound or a quiet sound?	Can you practise reading the following tricky words: to, the, no, go, I, into.	Make a rhyming book of things that rhyme with 'at'.	Practise writing your first and last name. 
Maths	Gather a range of objects and practise sorting them in different ways. You could sort them by colour, size or shape. What other ways could you sort them? You could use the objects you collect on your Autumn walk.	Play a board game that involves counting. Take a photograph or draw a picture of what you've done.	Practise making repeating patterns. You could use objects or colour your own. If you feel confident with two colours, try a more complex pattern as shown here. 	Practice counting a range of objects to 10 by 'touch counting'. Remember to say one number name at a time.	Can you measure the amount of rain that falls in your garden using an empty bottle? 
RE	In RE, we are learning all about God's Creation. Can you draw a picture of one of God's creations that you are thankful for? 	Make a thank you card for somebody who helps you.	Think about the special talents that God has given you. Bring in a photograph/ drawing of you doing this talent and share your talent with the class.	Practise making the 'Sign of the Cross' 	
Topic	Make an All About Me collage including all of your favourite things. 	Follow a recipe. Take photographs of the activity and/ or the finished food. 	Go for an Autumn walk and collect natural materials such as different coloured leaves. Make a collage showing the beautiful colours of Autumn. 	Draw a picture or make a model to show what type of house you live in. Can you learn your address? (street name and number)
