<p>The Physical Challenge</p> <p>How many times can you pass a ball through both of your legs in 60 seconds? If you drop the ball you need to pick it up quickly and carry on.</p> <p><i>Do you balance in yourself and keep trying if you drop the ball?</i></p> <p>#StayHomeStayActive</p>	<p>The Physical Challenge</p> <p>How many obstacles can you run around or jump over in 60 seconds? Be creative! Place out objects: pillows, teddies around the space. Each time you jump over an object you score a point.</p> <p><i>How will you move to make sure your jump as many as you can?</i></p> <p>#StayHomeStayActive</p>	<p>How to Play:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play in pairs or as a family. Everyone needs a skipping rope. If you do not have a skipping rope, jump on the spot. One person starts by shouting out an adjective (describing word) e.g. small. Everyone starts skipping and takes it in turns to shout out a synonym for the adjective e.g. tiny, little, titchy. Can you try doing it with a long rope? When it is your turn, run in and shout out your synonym. <p>Vocabulary Adjectives describe a person, place or object.</p> <p>small tiny little titchy</p>
<p>Equipment</p> <p>A ball</p> <p>If you do not have a ball use a toilet roll or a cuddly toy.</p>	<p>Equipment</p> <p>Lots of objects and a enough space on the floor!</p> <p>Use as many objects as you can. This game is best played outside in the garden.</p>	<p>Key Vocabulary</p> <p>Synonym</p> <p>A word or phrase that means exactly or nearly the same as another word or phrase.</p>
