You should try doing little bit of reading every day. Could you create a new cover or a bookmark for your book? There are lots of reading ideas on the reading page of the Y2 home learning website.



You could write a daily diary or write a diary for a character from a book you have read. Maybe even for an explorer—real or made up! Remember to practise your handwriting, grammar and punctuation as you are writing! There are also lots of games to practise these on the website.



Keep practising your mental maths everyday - Times Table Rock Stars is great for this and there are lots of good games on www.topmarks.co.uk. You could try seeing how many multiplication fact families you can make in your 2,5, and 10 time tables! Don't forget to practise telling the time—there are lots of activities to practise on the website's maths page!



Do some daily exercise - Joe Wicks, Cosmic Kids Yoga, Super Movers and Jump Start Jonny are all great sites. Maybe you could even make up your own fruit dance like the one we have done in PE together! Make sure you find time to go outside and get some fresh air!

Some other ideas for things you could try this week are:

Science - Could you go on a seasons walk? How are the plants around you changing now we are in Spring? What different creatures can you see? How is the weather changing?

RE - This week is **Holy Week**. Some important days are **Maunder Thursday** and **Good Friday** and of course, next Sunday is **Easter Sunday**- Read the stories of these special days with your family. There are activities to help you on the Learning site's RE pages.

Creative Curriculum- We have been looking at great explorers. Could you find out about another great explorer? Try looking for Francis Drake, Edmund Hillary, Robert Falcon Scott or Neil Armstrong.
