

- Homework—children will be given homework on a Friday. Homework books should be bought back into school on a Wednesday. Children will be set 1 piece of Homework a week as well as an optional Homework Grid, where they may choose to complete one of the activities.
- Fruit, milk and sugar free juice costs £1.50 per week and should be paid on a Monday morning. Children may bring their own fruit into school, if they would prefer to.



Things to Note. . .

- Reading Books are changed on a Monday, and a Thursday. Children need to bring their book bags to school everyday.
- PE is on a Wednesday and a Thursday, this half term. Children will get changed in school and need to have their kit in school, everyday.
- Spellings - weekly spellings are given every Monday to be practiced for a test on Friday.
- Forest School –Year 2 will take part in Forest School during the first half of the Autumn Term. Please ensure children are dressed appropriately and bring a pair of Wellies. Wellies may be kept in school during the half term.

English

In Literacy this term we will be looking at 'The Storm Whale'. We will be thinking about the characters in the story and we will be writing a Diary entry.

We will have daily phonics sessions. We will be revisiting the phase 5 graphemes, that we learnt in Year 1 and we will learn lots of different spelling rules.



Reading

In Year 2, we will encounter lots of different books and texts.

We will take part in independent and Guided Reading sessions and we will read to our teachers.

We will have a class story at the end of each day and children will bring home a library book each week.



Science

In our science unit this term we are looking at Animals including Humans. We will find out what animals need to survive, the importance of exercise and a healthy balanced diet. We will look at the life cycles of frogs, butterflies and chickens.



Religious Education

In RE we will know the following stories from the Old Testament: Noah and the Ark, David and Goliath, and Jonah and the Big Fish. We will know the important stories from the New Testament about Jesus, Mary and the call of the disciples, we will learn about Advent as a season of preparation for Christmas and we will know and be able to sequence the story of Christmas from the Annunciation to the flight into Egypt.

We will take part in class and whole school worship and say daily prayers.



Maths

In maths we will be learning how to solve calculations using all four operations. We will focus on place value and sequencing and we will learn how to solve maths problems

We will learn properties of 2D and 3D shapes including edges, vertices and faces and line symmetry .

We will also be learning about money, including recognising amounts and solving problems with money.

In mental maths our focus will be on counting in 2's, 5's and 10's and learning the multiplication facts for the x2, x5 and x10 times tables.



Topic

In Geography we are learning all about the United Kingdom. We will be looking at the 4 countries that make up the United Kingdom, finding where they are on a map and learning about the Landmarks. In each country. In History we will be learning all about The Great Fire of London.
